## Brinks Gilson & Lione Shareholder Laura Beth Miller Shares Litigation Strategies at PLI's Patent Litigation 2017

CHICAGO—Laura Beth Miller, a shareholder and litigator at intellectual property law firm Brinks Gilson & Lione, will be a featured presenter at the Practising Law Institute's (PLI) Patent Litigation 2017: Advanced Techniques & Best Practices program at the University of Chicago's Gleacher Center on October 12, 2017.

Miller will present "New Strategies for Asserting and Defending Against Infringement Claims Involving Acts of Multiple Parties." She will discuss the constantly evolving law following the U.S. Supreme Court's ruling in *Limelight v. Akamai* relating to infringement where not all steps are performed or all components supplied by one entity. Miller will also explore issues of extra-territoriality in view of the high court's decision in *Life Technologies Corp. v. Promega Corp.*

Miller is a deeply experienced intellectual property litigator whose practice focuses on patent, trade secret, and trademark law. She has more than two decades of trial and arbitration experience, and counsels clients on complex commercial issues, including licensing, antitrust, and contract matters affecting business operations, product services, and technology.
