Dr. Hartley's doctoral research was supported by numerous fellowships and awards, including a National Research Service Award from the National Cancer Institute and a Whitaker International Summer Grant. He has developed acoustically sensitive liposomes using bioconjugation techniques to attach peptides and oligonucleotides to poly(*N*-(2-hydroxypropyl) methacrylamide) (HPMA), and produced, purified, and characterized monoclonal antibodies for therapeutic applications.

Dr. Hartley is listed as author or coauthor on eight peer-reviewed scientific manuscripts. His experience teaching undergraduate and graduate courses has taught him how to effectively communicate complicated topics so they are easily understandable.

Hartley joins 6 attorneys who have joined Brinks Gilson & Lione in the past few months, as the intellectual property boutique firm—already one of the largest in the US—extends its national reach. The firm has recently added lawyers in Chicago, Washington DC, Tampa, and Salt Lake.
