Attorneys Remus, Schigelone, Lee Speak at PLI's Patent Fundamentals Bootcamp 2017

CHICAGO—Mark H. Remus, Jason W. Schigelone, and Peter Lee, attorneys at intellectual property law firm Brinks Gilson & Lione, were featured speakers at the Practising Law Institute's (PLI) three-day Patent Fundamentals Bootcamp 2017: An Introduction to Patent Drafting, Prosecution, and Litigation, at the University of Chicago's Gleacher Center on May 9, 10, and 11, 2017.

The program offered early-career patent prosecutors, patent litigators, and patent agents an overview of the basics of claim drafting and patent application preparation and prosecution, as well as of recent developments in patent law. In lectures and small working groups, participants gained insights into invention disclosure and patent preparation, prosecution and issuance, and litigation and claim analysis.
